BIG BEND TRANSIT, INC.

This Contract is entered into between Big Bend Transit, Inc. hereinafter referred to as the "Operator" and The Able Trust, hereinafter referred to as the "Coordinator". The parties agree as follows:

I. THE OPERATOR SHALL:

A. Provide services and vehicles according to the conditions specified in Attachment 1.

B. Federal and State Laws and Regulations:

1. Comply with applicable provisions contained in Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, as amended (20 U.S.C. 1681 ET SEQ.) THE Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended (42 U.S.C. 6101 et seq.), and the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981, P.L. 97-35, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as it may be amended.
2. Comply with Section 341.061 F.S. and Rule 14-90 FAC concerning System Safety.

C. Indemnification

Indemnify, defend, and hold harmless, to the extent permitted by Florida law, the Coordinator from all claims, suits, judgments or damages, including court costs and attorney's fees, arising out of this contract.

D. Insurance

Provide, at a minimum, vehicle liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000 at all times during the existence of this contract. Operator shall furnish to the Coordinator, prior to beginning service under this contract, a Certificate of Insurance, specifying coverage as required in this paragraph.

E. Assignment and Subcontracts

Not assign its responsibility under this contract to another party nor subcontract for any of the work contemplated under this contract without prior written approval of the Coordinator.

II. THE COORDINATOR SHALL:

A. Authorize and Assign Trips

Authorize and assign trips to the Operator as specified in Attachment 1

III. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

A. Effective Date

1. This contract shall begin the date last executed by both parties.
2. This contract shall end on July 23, 2017. *at midnight.*

Dear Administrator/Director:

The Department of Children & Families (DCF) previously granted Van Johnson a DCF exemption from disqualification on May 1, 2003, for disqualifying offenses.
