### **Grant Policy**

#### **Process for Grant Requests from The Able Trust**

##### **Eligibility**

**A. Applicants:** The Able Charitable Foundation, Inc. (Foundation) has established a simplified Grant Application for funding requests from The Able Trust, to more quickly consider matching donor-advised requests to programs operated or directed by the Able Trust. In order to be eligible for this streamlined application process, The Able Trust must maintain its 501(c)(3) status and demonstrate outcomes in serving the training and employment-related needs of individuals with disabilities in Florida.

##### **B. Application Process:**

1. Grant requests of the Able Charitable Foundation by The Able Trust for projects that can be partially funded with donor-advised funds may be made via a letter of request, and will not initially require a full grant proposal as per the Able Charitable Grant Policy.
2. The Letter requesting funding should contain the following:
  - Brief description of the project or program to be funded.
  - Amount being requested.
  - Donor or endowment fund of Able Charitable that supports the program, if any. The name of the donor or endowment fund must be included in the letter.
  - Date funds are needed.
  - Outcomes and deliverables for the project or program.
  - Additional information as requested by the Foundation Board or staff
3. The Able Charitable Foundation Board should acknowledge and take action on the funding request within 60 days of receipt.
4. The grant may be awarded in the amount requested, or in any amount so designated by the Foundation.
5. The timing of the award and outcome measurement requirements shall be decided on a case by case basis. Other than requests related to donor-directed funding, the Foundation has the discretion to fund, partially fund or deny any grant requests from The Able Trust.
